- B) Bath Abbey is a stunning architectural masterpiece located in the heart of Bath, known for its impressive Perpendicular Gothic style. Founded in the 7th century, it features intricate fan vaulting and beautiful stained-glass windows that create a serene atmosphere. The iconic west front showcases unique sculptures of angels on ladders, symbolizing a connection to heaven. Visitors can explore its rich history, attend various events, or simply enjoy the peaceful ambiance of this remarkable landmark.
- C) The Circus in Bath is an impressive circular structure designed by John Wood the Elder, completed in 1768.
